What is Fixed Price Surgery?

Our Fixed Price Surgery scheme offers patients an all inclusive price for a wide range of operations and treatments. Prices are fixed before your admission and, subject to our terms and conditions, cover the full cost of your stay at The New Victoria Hospital.

The prices include the following:

- All costs of the hospital treatment for which you were admitted during your stay
- Consultant surgeon's and anaesthetist's fees, for services provided during your hospital stay
- Theatre and nursing care
- Tests, drugs, dressings and physiotherapy during your stay
- Accommodation, meals and a daily newspaper of your choice

Your stay

The length of your stay will be determined by your consultant. Unlike many private hospitals, our fixed prices are not subject to a maximum number of days stay. No extra charge will be made if, due to a recognised complication of your surgery, you need to stay for longer than originally expected. However you will not be entitled to a refund if you are discharged earlier than expected.

What you need to know

Your consultant

All our surgeons and anaesthetists hold or have held consultant posts within the NHS. All are experts in their chosen fields and the hospital is fully equipped to offer an extensive range of medical and surgical procedures.

If you have not already been referred to a consultant by your GP we should be happy to provide you with the names of relevant consultants who work at The New Victoria Hospital.

Your booking

Your consultant will arrange your admission date which we will confirm in writing along with the fixed price for your treatment. At the same time we ask you to complete and return a Registration Form and Health Questionnaire. Providing us with this essential information enables us to offer you a faster and more efficient service on your arrival at The New Victoria Hospital, and enables us to assess your suitability for Fixed Price Surgery.

You are required to pay in advance for Fixed Price Surgery. We will give you a full refund if you cancel before admission (see Terms and Conditions). However if you decide not to proceed with your operation after you have been admitted, we will charge you in full for the relevant treatment you have received.

Your admission

After completing the registration process in reception, a nurse will take you to your room and help you settle in. Your surgeon and anaesthetist will normally visit you before your operation to explain the procedure and answer any questions you may have regarding your treatment.

Prostheses

Where prostheses, such as artificial hips and knees, are not included in the fixed price, we will provide an estimate of their likely cost prior to your admission.

Your account - Extras

At the end of your stay you will be billed for telephone calls, visitors' meals and other services which are not part of your Fixed Price Surgery. We require you to settle these extras at the time of your discharge from hospital.

What is not included in your Fixed Price Surgery

- All visits to your consultant before your admission and after your discharge
- Hospital treatment and tests prior to your admission and after your discharge including: X-rays, scans, blood and other pathology tests, physiotherapy and medical supplies and equipment such as crutches
- Additional nights' accommodation when it is not required on medical grounds
- Hotel charges including telephone calls, alcoholic drinks and meals for your visitors
- Accommodation for a parent accompanying a child
- Ambulance transport
- Drugs and dressings to take home for use after your discharge

How to settle your account

Our aim is to put your mind at rest by making as many of the financial and administrative arrangements as possible before your admission date.

We accept the following methods of payment:

- Cheque
- Bank transfer or Internet bank transfer
- Cash
- Mastercard and Visa credit cards

If you pay by cheque we ask that you pay five days in advance so that your cheque may be cleared prior to your admission. Please make your cheque payable to The New Victoria Hospital.

Terms and conditions

- We reserve the right to amend our prices or to refuse you treatment at our fixed prices if we have concerns that your general medical conditions might result in complications
- The Registration Form contains a financial agreement which we ask you to sign. By signing it you recognise and accept your responsibility for settling your account. If the patient is under 18 years of age, the agreement should be signed by the patient's parent, guardian, or legal representative
- If you do not pay in full for your treatment prior to your admission we reserve the right to cancel or postpone your admission
- We will give you a full refund if you cancel before your admission. However if you decide not to proceed with your operation after you have been admitted, we will charge you in full for the services that you have received.
- You are not entitled to a refund if you are discharged earlier than expected
